This Panel combines analyses of energy politics from an International Political Economy/IR perspective with the emerging approach of comparative regionalism. Globally, we will look at the changes in energy markets of oil, gas and renewables, addressing questions of governance and the way old and new institutions (like OPEC, IEA, IRENA, G7 and G20) have been trying to regulate them. From a comparative regionalism perspective, contributions to the Panel shall analyse formal regional organizations focusing on energy, as well as examples of informal regionalism and regionalization.
