The Advocacy Coalition Framework (ACF) has been applied to study the formation of coalitions, policy learning, and policy change in a variety of countries and policy domains. Most of these studies, however, are case studies of one policy process in one country. We welcome all ACF papers, but particularly encourage contributions that use the ACF to compare policy processes across countries or policy domains and/or engage in theoretical dialogue between the ACF and other policy process frameworks.
