





Authored by some of the most outstanding academics in the IPSA community, IPSAMOOC is a joint project with Federica Web Learning - University of Naples Federico II that offers free online political science courses. Since its launch in 2016, over 100,000 people worldwide have benefited from IPSAMOOC courses in English and Spanish on the largest MOOC providers, Coursera and edX.

To expand its global reach and serve a diverse audience, IPSAMOOOC launched multilingual subtitles for its political science courses on Coursera. The introduction of French, Japanese, Spanish, and Turkish subtitles marks a significant step forward in IPSAMOOOC's goal to provide high-quality political science education in languages other than English.




IPSA Summer Schools give social sciences scholars access to high-quality advanced training in qualitative and quantitative research methods in social and political science. To help students advance their methodological skillset and establish connections with peers from all over the world, IPSA collaborates with local universities worldwide since 2010 to organize summer schools in methodology. IPSA presently offers six annual summer schools: Antalya, Naples, Mexico City, São Paulo, Singapore, and Spain. IPSA also organizes the IPSA-Concordia Summer Institute in Applied Diplomacy in Montréal since 2021.
