



Guidelines for co-funding events by the ECPR Standing Group on International Relations

The ECPR Standing Group on International Relations (SGIR) invites applications from its members for co-funding events benefiting the internationalisation of IR scholarship in Europe. Applications can be submitted on a rolling basis.

Opportunities for co-funding

Co-funding is typically limited to EUR 1,000 for events with 10 or more participants, EUR 2,000 for 20 or more participants, and EUR 3,000 for events with more than 30 participants. Please allow about three months for approval from the SGIR Steering Committee and ECPR Executive Committee. Successful applicants will need to invoice ECPR for the full amount awarded. The final transfer by ECPR can take up to four weeks after the invoice has been sent. Please keep this timeline in mind when submitting your request.

How to apply

To apply for co-funding, please send us a short description of the event including:

- Title
- Date
- Location
- Format
- 200-word abstract
- A brief explanation of how the funds will be used to contribute to the success of the event
- List of participants (incl. information listed as criteria below, such as gender and career status)
- 200-word outline of how our co-funding will be acknowledged (e.g., in the programme and/or event homepage, tagging ECPR on social media, and/or mentioning our support at the opening of the event)

Please note that a 500-word summary will be required within one month after the event, detailing the program and acknowledgment of funding.

Criteria

When considering co-funding requests, preference will be given to events organised by individuals rather than professional organisations, events that bring together scholars from at least three ECPR member countries, and events with a balanced representation of female scholars and scholars at different career stages. The Standing Group does not fund individual panels or workshops within broader events such as conferences.
